## WELCOME TO FESTIVAL'S POP-UP CAMP

**The camp is free of charge and intended for festival visitors.  
For a more pleasant stay, please follow the campsite rules.**

### ARRIVING

Upon arrival, you can drive up to the campsite to unload your gear, but parking is limited to 15 minutes. Afterwards, please move your car to the designated parking area, as directed by the camp managers. Please request access to the campsite by phoning the number +385 99 8291 706

The camp is located about 10-minute walking distance from the Rakov Jarak festival centre, and about half an hour from the centre of Fužine. You can also use the festival train or night taxi shuttle, at the following prices:

- Single-use return ticket – €3
- Day pass – €6
- Festival pass – €10
- Single night ticket – €4

The night taxi shuttle runs from 23:00, every hour on the hour, until the end of the music program.

**IMPORTANT** Day and weekly passes for the festival train are not valid for night rides.

### CAMPERS' CODE

Paying the tourist tax in the amount of €1.20 per day is mandatory for all visitors (this obligation is legally prescribed for all tourists in the Republic of Croatia). The fee is charged on a per-person rate, not per tent. It is assumed that all campers will stay until the end of the festival, so the tourist tax is calculated on this basis – from the moment of registration until the last day of the program. Camp check-in is possible at the camp reception desk at Lake Lepenica.

**PLEASE NOTE** The tourist tax is only payable in cash. In addition to the camp registration, you need to purchase one of the festival ticket bundles. If you did not buy either the Big Hill or the Little Hill ticket bundles in presale, you are required to buy the Camping Bundle consisting of 5 tickets for €25 upon camp registration. Ticket bundles can be exchanged for individual tickets for the screenings of your choice at the festival box office. It is advisable to secure any of the ticket bundles that will allow you to register for the camp

before heading to the campsite – by purchasing online or at the festival ticket office. Festival accreditation holders may stay at the camp without purchasing tickets. The organiser will provide you with a festival wristband which indicates that you have properly registered and regulated your camper status – please wear them at all times during the festival. You will be able to exchange your ticket bundles for individual tickets or leave your mobile phone to charge only by presenting your wristband. There are showers available at the camp. We ask that you only use organic soaps and shampoos in these showers.

All unregistered campers run the risk of considerable fines for an unregistered stay, which are prescribed by the tourist inspection.

**IMPORTANT** The water in the camp is not for drinking. Please use it only for personal hygiene.

### SAFETY NOTICE

This area is part of a facility for electricity production, so for your personal safety, please exercise caution. Therefore, we ask that you:

- Be careful when walking along the dam walkway, avoid behaviour that puts you at risk of falling over the edge
- Pay special attention when walking along the dam at night
- Please dismount and push bicycles along the walkway over the dam
- Only swim at designated beaches; swimming near the dam is prohibited and can be extremely dangerous
- In the event of inclement weather, be sure to move away from wooded areas, so that you are completely safe from possible falling branches.

**LEAVE NO TRACE: It is a matter of the festival's honour that we do not leave even a scrap of paper behind! Dispose of your waste responsibly and be considerate of this beautiful environment.**
